JUNIOR OPEN DIVISION

There are 7 teams in the division. We have separated the teams into two pods one with 3 teams and one with 4 teams. Teams with the first and second best record in each pod advances to the semi final round on Sunday morning.

* Due to an odd number of teams (3) in Pod# 1, the following procedure will be used. The team with the lowest tie breaker score will be given an automatic win for their third game with the other two teams playing their third game against each other. This match will be played during the 8:30pm shift on Saturday.

All ties for any position will be decided using the tie breaking method below. The advancing teams will then be ranked 1 - 4 for the semi finals based on their record with Tie Breakers used. The winners of the Sunday morning games will with advance to the Gold Medal game and the two losing teams will play for the Bronze medal.

ADULT OPEN DIVISION

There are 8 teams in this division. The teams are divided into two pods of four teams each. The 1st and second place team from each pod advances to the semi final round on Sunday. All ties will be decided using the tie breaking method below. The advancing teams will then be ranked 1 - 4 for the semi finals based on record with Tie Breakers used if need. The winners of the Sunday morning games will advance to the Gold Medal game and the two losing teams will play for the Bronze medal.

MEN'S DIVISION

There are 8 teams in this division. The teams are divided into two pods of four teams each. The 1st and second place team from each pod advances to the semi final round on Sunday. All ties will be decided using the tie breaking method below. The advancing teams will then be ranked 1 - 4 for the semi finals based on record with Tie Breakers used if need. The winners of the Sunday morning games will advance to the Gold Medal game and the two losing teams will play for the Bronze medal.

RULE MODIFICATION: When teams are playing matches vs. one of the wheelchair teams, there will be a rules modification of NO SWEEPING once the stone passes the T-LINE of the end being played.

TIE BREAKING METHOD

After the first game in each division is played, each member of the team will throw one rock trying to get as close to the center of the button as possible. The cumulative distance of the teams four throws measured in inches from the center of the button will be used in any tie breaking situations during the tournament. **NOTE:** This will be draw weight only, no sweeping will be permitted for the tie breaker throws.

* If there is a situation were two teams have the same tie breaking number and the tie cannot be broken we will have a coin toss to break the tie.
